Good afternoon, Kim!

I have read the Livable Frederick master plan pages concerning commuting patterns in the county, which states that 33% of Frederick County commuters travel to jobs outside the county.

Does the County have any further breakdown of those commuting patterns--such as whether those destinations are in another Maryland county, or to another state (such as Virginia)? I'm specifically interested in how many commute to jobs within Maryland (down 270, etc.) and how many work in Virginia (Tysons Corner area or points west). I know some Loudoun County staff are Maryland residents, for example.

One Loudoun planning commissioner I spoke with made reference to what he described as your county's ballooning housing growth--as playing a part in Loudoun's need to widen the road. I would like to have some good data to get back to him with.

If your data doesn't get that granular, but you know where I might be able to find it, I'd really appreciate your help.
